Saint Joseph University Parish, an active parish of approximately 750 households and with a substantial campus ministry, invites applicants for the position of Director of Music and Liturgy.

As the Director of Liturgy and Music this person is responsible for the effective preparation, coordination, leadership, and performance of music for parish liturgies. Applicants should be comfortable with a range of musical styles, ranging from traditional to contemporary. Choral directing, singing and piano skills are essential. Additional responsibilities include the training and coordination of liturgical ministers. Strong communication and managerial skills are necessary in both areas.

The successful applicant will be a person of strong faith; have a thorough understanding of Roman Catholic liturgy; and hold a Bachelor's degree in Music or Liturgical Music, or have comparable experience in liturgical music ministry. Compensation will be commensurate with education and experience.

Applicants responding by June 1st will be given preferential consideration though screening will continue until the position is filled.
